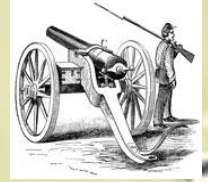


1862 CIVIL WAR SCHOOL PROGRAM 2012

By order of the Territorial Governor the Nebraska Territory will raise volunteers for the 1st Nebraska Volunteer Infantry. Volunteers will muster for service, May 11, 1862

Recruits will:

- Learn of Nebraska's Role
- Hear about the battles of Fort Donelson and Shiloh (1st Nebraska's major battles)
- Identify at least 3 important dates in the Civil War
- Compare/Contrast the motivations of Union and Confederate soldiers
- Explain the role of woman in the Civil War
- Name at least 4 military or political figures of the 1860's
- Define the terms, States Rights, Muster, Enlistment, Campaign, Surgeon, and Gangrene

Camp of Instruction

- > Obtain enlistment papers
- > Take the oath of enlistment
- > Learn to march and maneuver
- > Report to camp surgeon for health inspection
- > Receive basic instruction loading and firing a cannon
- > Witness activities on the home front
- > Meet General Grant!
