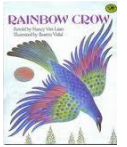
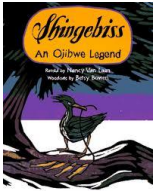


Kutatiraa'itusta "These Are My Stories"

In the *pakuhtu'* (long ago) Pawnee children learned about their world from stories told by the elders. Now your students can learn from the same, stories, so that they can also say "*Kutatiraa'itusta*, these are my stories"



Program Objectives

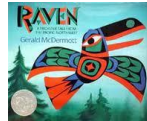
Students will:

- Understand how myths were used as a teaching tool for Native American children
- Define "personification" and "moral of the story"
- Describe the role of birds and animals in Native American myths
- Compare the myths of different Indian nations
- Increase understanding of other cultures, and their beliefs
- Practice reading aloud skills
- Practice public speaking skills
- Use creative thinking and improve creative writing skills
- Practice character education
